

**VI.**

**METAL POLICY**

- **SHREE SHANTMOHANAM PEANUTS** shall carry out hazard analysis on a regular basis to assess the risk of metal contamination in raw materials, semi-finished goods and finished goods.
- If hazard analysis concludes that there is a risk of metal contamination in finished products, a metal detector / Magnets will be installed at appropriate places and necessary checks will be performed to eliminate metal contamination.
- Wherever possible, all objects which are likely to come in contact with finished goods shall be of non-corrosive metals.
- All structural and supporting systems in production area and warehouses shall be maintained in an appropriate manner to eliminate any chipping, flaking and peeling of paint.
- Pens, Watches and Jewelry shall not be allowed in production areas, material movement paths and warehouses.
- Awareness and necessity of Metal Policy shall be a part of the orientation program for all new employees.
- A register shall be maintained for all sharps articles (blades) which are absolutely required to be kept in production areas and warehouses. All items listed in the register shall be monitored at regular Interval.
- If any item listed in Blades register is found missing, production & dispatch related activities shall be stopped immediately and matter should be reported to shift supervisor. Shift supervisor must locate missing item before re-starting production and dispatch activities.
- Awareness and necessity of Metal Policy shall be a part of the orientation program for all new employees.
